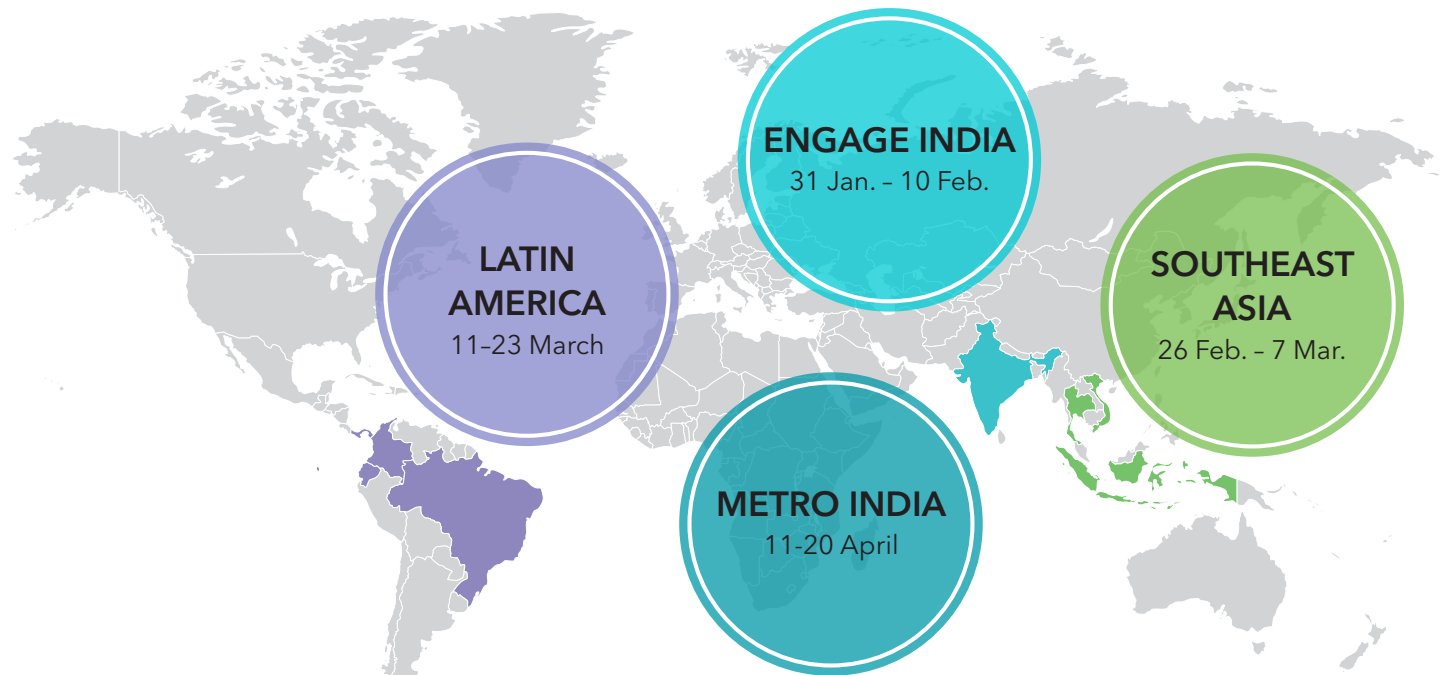

TOUR APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please complete the attached application form and submit it with the required deposit. Payment of the balance of the tour cost is due 60 days prior to the commencement of the tour. If tour fees are not received 60 days before commencement of tour, the institution may be dropped from the tour and cancellation fees will apply. KIC UnivAssist may choose to break the tour group into multiple groups with a similar construct to the original tour to retain the small group format in case the number of participants exceeds 15. If for any reason KIC UnivAssist cannot accommodate an institution on the tour, their fees including deposits will be fully refunded.
